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Bringing awareness of the real Palestine



Recent bombardment by land sea and air by Israel on the civilian population of Gaza continues to horrify the public. But atrocities on the people of Palestine never end on a ceasefire. An evening event held at the Al-Hikmah centre focussed on showing the wider difficulties and apartheid faced by Palestinians after the cameras have been switched

Chair of IMWS, Mohamed Mulla, opened the evening, which saw representatives from all three house at the centre.

Molana Hashim Sacha, chair of Rabetah Ulema Batley, delivered a presentation outlining the geography of Palestine and its importance within Islam.

Director of the Middle East Monitor, Dawood Abdullah, in a passionate speech raised the many concerns and questions humanity has been asking. Dr Abdullah asked when hospitals, schools and children playing on the beach are targets "where is jusunder international law, Palestinians should be protected as they are under occupation, yet the US and UK are providing arms to the occupier, Israel.

He added, "Israel has decided how many calories the Palestinian people should be having everyday, that is how calculated and insidious they are being,

"Israel is a state that thinks and acts like it's above the law."

His talk hit home the feelings within people in the audience from all backgrounds and faiths.

Rabbi Cohen, from Manchester, explained the difference between Judism and Zionism, stressing "we are all shocked, horrified and sickened by what we have seen." He explained how for centuries Muslims, Christians and Jews have lived side by side in a region important to all three faiths.

He explained how Zionism is relatively new and does not reflect true Judism, and how the Zionist view of an Israeli state contravenes their own belief.

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


Their will be a lot of battles and setbacks ahead, but we must all be steadfast and ensure our message gets across to the wider community.



"Muslims and Jews have lived peacefully for hundreds of years, up until the Zionists came along and said, 'we're taking over because it says so in the Bible,' yet they don't even believe in the Bible. How ridiculous is the logic

behind that?" Said Rabbi Cohen.

Bishop Tony Robinson, Bishop of Pontefract, also condemned the slaughter in Gaza saying he was appalled by what was

happening and how the public at large had been "horrified by the pictures we've seen."

Local pensioner Ken Hodgson spent three months between January and April this year in Area C of the West Bank as part of a project by Ecumenical Accompaniment Programme in Palestine and Israel (EAPPI).

He explained how EAPPI remain apolitical and do not take sides, neither being pro-Palestinian or pro-Israeli, but take only the side of human rights.

In a slide show presentation Mr Hodgson told the story of a number of cases where human rights abuses had been witnessed.

The rights of Palestinians on such basic matters as drinking water and the imposed restrictions by Israel shocked many listeners, and brought an awareness of how Palestinian farmers and people in general were being driven to destruction.

As he recalled stories of individuals having been targeted openly by the IDF and the illegal settlers, which amount to around half a million now, the long term suffering became more visible.

"Demolitions of houses are cyclic, Palestinians are forced off their land, denied building permits - so they are forced to build houses without permits - the Israelies then demolish unauthorised houses because they don't have permits." He said.

Mr Hodgson said not all settlers are alike. He mentioned their were armed fanatics who carry guns in public, arms directly funded and made in the US, and how these fanatics have served in the Israeli

military and therefore know how to use these weapons to kill.

Harrowing stories of teenagers being taken from schools beaten before witnesses and then taken for a greater beating by the IDF was common, he said.



Friends of Al-Aqsa chair, Ismail Patel, pointed out how we are all conditioned by the media and only take note once the bombing starts. Once the media goes quiet, so do we.

He told the audience how social media has played a big part and how this has its own pros and cons

In a brief but powerful address he said, "Activism without knowledge is dangerous – peoples energy is being wasted. Just as knowledge without activism is also dangerous.

"Be informed. Join reputable organisations like FOA. Organise your activism for an impact.

"There is no point having a list of 20 companies to boycott for it to then fizzle out, target your boycotting for maximum impact."

FOA have a seven point action plan on their website which the public is being encouraged to support.

The Chair of IMWS, Mohamed Mulla, said, "The feeling is running very high amongst the people of Batley and Dewsbury. Irrespective of people's religious beliefs everyone feels very strongly about the indiscriminate slaughter of women and children by the IDF. I hope that by doing this event the core issues have been highlighted and people have better understanding of what other actions they can take to register their disapproval of Israeli oppression in the Palestine."

All the speakers showed their support for lobbying MPs and the BDS campaign as a way to bring about a lasting peace in the region.

Boycott in mind

The atrocities committed by the Israeli government against the people of Gaza, has led many to take action.

Although many may feel helpless at the situation in Gaza as the Israeli Defence Forces massacre thousands of innocent Gazans, amongst them many who happen to be women and children, there is one effective way in which your voice can be heard – boycott.

Innovative Minds have been working on educating and promoting a boycott of companies who actively support Israel as it continues to commit war crimes.

The Boycott Divestment and Sanctions movement isn't new; it is a global campaign that has been going since 2005. The BDS's aims are to put economic and political pressure on Israel to end the suffering it has imposed on Palestine.

There is real power in boycott. The boycott of South Africa played a key role in bringing an end to the apartheid era.

Website Innovative Minds puts together a list of companies that have dealings with Israel to provide better knowledge to those who object to Israeli oppression of Palestinian people.

One of the biggest names on the boycott list is soft drinks producer Coca-Cola. It has a long standing association with Israel, in fact in 1997 Coca-Cola was honoured by an Israeli Governmental Economic Mission, for its support of Israel and refusal to accept the Arab League boycott of Israel.

Coca-Cola also honoured war-criminal Brigadier-General Ben-Eliezer – the man responsible for the execution of over 300 Egyptian POWs. Ben-Eliezer also served as a Defence Minister under Ariel Sharon.

The JCC Maccabi Games which has a goal of cultivating Jewish youth to "encourage their identification with the state of Israel" is sponsored by Coca-Cola, as part of this Coca-Cola has sponsored young children to visit Israeli military bases.

These are just some of the ways in which everyone's favourite beverage maker has been funding Israel.

There are other names whose

boycott is urged as well. Nestle is the world's largest food company and it also happens to own over 53% of Osem, the Israeli food manufacturer worth over \$850million.

Nestle also has nine factories in Israel and when you compare that to the number of factories it has in China (18) and Russia (11) and the comparative size differences in these countries it shows the clear support Israel has of Nestle.

McDonalds and Starbucks are both exposed to the boycott as well. The call for a boycott on McDonald is due to its corporate links to the Jewish United Fund (which runs family missions to Israel, which incorporates trips to Israeli military bases) and the Jewish Federation (Its task is to fight campaigns that equate Israel with apartheid South Africa).

Coffee giant Starbucks' founder Howard Schultz is an active Zionist. He has been showered with honours by pro-Zionist bodies and his propaganda has been praised by the Israeli Foreign Ministry as key to Israel's PR success.

Then there is the need to check the label on fresh fruit and vegetables. Friends of Al-Aqsa ran a successful campaign in persuading Muslims to boycott Israeli dates during Ramadan.

The same needs to be done on other fruit and vegetable which comes from Israel year around for an effective boycott to be implemented.

Electronic giants Motorola, Intel and IBM are also listed on the boycott list for various dealings with Israel, in Motorola's case providing the Israeli army with means to communicate.

Despite the quantity of major companies, many whom we've come to rely on to provide valuable services to us in our daily lives. The inconveniences are minor compared to the suffering of Gazans.

The hope is that an effective boycott will put sufficient pressure on these firms to either pullout or for them in turn to put pressure on the Israeli government to end the persecution of Palestine.

Ceasefire but not a time to sleep

After 50 days of relentless death and destruction a ceasefire was brokered by the Egyptians, but this is not the time for the world at large to fall back into hibernation awakening only when the bombs start falling again.

The ceasefire itself really doesn't promise much more than what the ceasefire in 2012 promised - that was never delivered. But Israel and its political supporters worldwide have suffered more than they expected.

Its international reputation took an absolute pasting and can not be attributed to governments but the public worldwide. Scenes of protests flew down social media timelines almost blanking any other posts.

This has had an impact not only on Israel but governments across the world. What had started with governments backing Israel in public press releases soon went to silence, and although the humanitarian suffering of the Gazans didn't receive the sympathetic dialogue leaders should have given, the silence spoke of what the public had achieved.

Of course in any protest or demonstration we all want political leaders to step up to a press conference pedestal and announce support for public opinion, but this rarely happens in reality.

Public pressure through protests and boycotts does work, but falling silent when the jobs not done wipes away all that's gained faster.

It's why now is not the time to sleep, but to keep our eyes wide open through lobbying, boycotting and being aware of what is happening across

MY JOURNEY TO PALESTINE

Elevan year old Haarisah Pandor from Dewsbury along with her family visited Masjid Al-Aqsa and Palestine this Ramadhaan. Below she gives a brief account of her experience.

he day had finally arrived. After months of waiting excitement filled my heart. I could already smell the warm, musky, spicy smell of the old city in my mind.

Alhamdulillah at around 3pm on the 24th July 2014 which was the 26th fast of Ramadan and the 27th taraweeh we entered Palestine. After freshening up we started our short walk to Al-AQSA for maghrib. As soon as we set foot outside I could feel the sad sombre atmosphere in the air. Looking around me I could see lots of mini checkpoints which were surrounded by the Israeli soldiers carrying big snipers. After going through several checkpoints we were stopped at the last one. Myself, my mum and the rest of the women in our group were allowed to go through but my brother uncle and cousin were not. My mum was holding on to my brother trying to tell the soldiers he was only 12, but they didn't care. It made me think about those Palestinian boys who travel all the way from the west bank just to pray in this blessed masiid only to be stopped. Stopped for absolutely nothing. As I started walking towards the masjid the happiness in my heart drained and the same sombre feeling took its place. I

kept thinking if my family were going to be safe. That's when I fully understood what life was actually like for the Palestinians.

Throughout the taraweeh all prayers

we heard were gunshots, rubber bullets and tear gas being fired. We had no idea what was going on. I was beginning to feel anxious about my family but looking around me all the Palestinians looked so calm. Again I realised that it is because this is normal life for them. How sad I thought to myself. After a very emotional Dua we started heading back to our hotel. There was chaos everywhere, the streets were littered with stones, fire was burning in a skip and the vans that spray the disgusting chemical water were everywhere. Once again my thoughts drifted to my family. A sense of relief came over me when we saw them near our hotel.

My brother said they had tried for at least 5 hours to try and get



into AL-AQSA but with no success. Angry and frustrated they gave up and prayed on the streets outside. The next day jumma was the same. Even then the Palestinians don't give up. They continue to take the short journey from their homes, which can take hours due to the checkpoints.

The rest of the week was pretty calm. We met lots of lovely people, who welcomed us open heartedly. But the people of Palestine don't want us to weep for them. They want us to go there and see Palestine with our own eyes. They want us to show our solidarity to them. Even if you don't have the opportunity you can always show your support by boycotting companies that support Israel.

Warsi resigns over PM's 'morally indefensible' stand

Baroness Sayeeda Warsi's resignation last month was greeted by humanitarians across the country with a cheer. Not for leaving her post but because a Tory peer had spoken out and said what the public had been saying for weeks.

In an interview with Channel 4 News, the Baroness from Dewsbury called the government's stance 'morally indefensible' and suggested David Cameron had been 'mealy mouthed' over the attacks.

"I think for me, it's morally indefensible.

"More than a quarter of the Gazan population displaced, nearly 2,000 people killed, nearly 400 innocent children killed - we still cannot find the words to say we condemn this

"These issues are far too serious for us to have been mealymouthed and for us to be dragging our heels," she said.

Lady Warsi had already been guite vocal on the recent Israeli attacks through her Twitter account, and spoke of her regret for not speaking out last year during the Palestinian appeal for UN recognition, where Britain opted not to vote.

But her decision to resign over it displayed a frustration against her party's leadership.

The former senior Foreign Office minister must have had detailed discussions, (and her resignation letter certainly says she did) with fellow ministers and the PM regarding the British government's position.

Even her resignation was posted on Twitter first, showing what seems to be a real annovance against the stance David Cameron has taken on this massacre.

Following her resignation she told the BBC "By resigning and stepping down I can live with myself."

Lady Warsi in 2011 stated 'Islamophobia has passed the dinner table test'

Her resignation though tipped by the PM's stance on Gaza might not be solely for that reason. It is well known high level campaigns to remove her from her positions have been on going for years.

Lady Warsi has said in an interview her resignation will allow her to speak more freely. She is also known to have been keeping a diary. When, and if, that hits the bookstores, it is likely to reveal what has really been happening whilst this northern Muslim woman has been trying to represent minorities and faiths in a government that has pushed both far down the order.

THE FALLACY OF ISRAELI CLAIMING VICTORY OVER HAMAS

here are some who may argue that Hamas won the current war although it still seems to be continuing. Although some experts may argue that Israel suffered much less casualties and Hamas have been dealt with a significantly blow in terms of loss of live and other capabalaties.

Israel almost certainly may be able to claim a tactical victory but

they have suffered a strategic defeat.

At a tactical level the Iron Dome defence system has kept Israeli casualties to a minimum. Furthermore many Hamas tunnels have been destroyed and their capabality of firing rockets have been significantly reduced.

However the strategic victory belongs to Hamas and the Palestinians. Israeli citizens

have enjoyed a high standard of living and have given the impression to the world of a stable and vibrant democracy. Hamas strategic objective is to shatter Israel's sense of normality and tranquillity. Just look at the reaction and panic of the Israel government when Ben Gurion Airport was closed because of a rocket landing near the airport.

During the dark days of Apartheid , I remember arguing with Londoners explaining to them that South Africa was not a true democracy and often the high standard of living of a minority was often at the expense of the

poor majority. Do not be fooled by the pictures of beautiful beaches in Cape Town and Skyscrapers of Johannesburg, Beneath the surface there was tremendous internal turmoil even amongst the minority Afrikaner People. My view is that this conception is starting to emerge regarding the image of Israel around the world.



Similarly the persistent low level firing of Hamas rockets has cause enormous disruption. Rockets triggered warning sirens in almost all major Israeli cities. Tourism must have definitely fallen during the recent conflict.

Whilst the rockets thankfully have not taken many lives, they have certainly created a sense of panic, leaving people to often scramble for shelters several times a day and shattered the illusion of invincibility and the fact that what happens in Gaza does not affect life in Israel.

Hamas may have already won the strategic war. Thousands of Palestinian casualties especially the often one sided bombardment, has led many in Western eyes, to perceive Israel as the aggressor. Secondly to many people around the world, Hamas now seen as the defender of Palestinian people and also the champion of Palestinian rights and self determination. They are now admired for withstanding

> an onslaught from one of the worlds largest and most powerful armies. This was not the aim of the Israeli government or indeed their citizens.

> The high casualties by the Israel army in relevant terms have also exposed the vulnerability of the Israel army in dealing with a small resistance group with very little sophisticated weapons but a lot of cunning, steadfastness and also determination which

has perhaps taken Israeli by surprise. Many people around the world may no longer view Hamas as a terrorist group after witnessing the wanton and unnecessary destruction in Gaza.

Furthermore in the absence of many achivements the Israelis are also trying to fake the fall of Hamas. The world has seen the destruction and mass killing perpertrated by IDF soldiers and whilst the Israeli government may dismiss the huge global criticism as anti Semitism, most people are now seeing through this argument and have seen the destruction caused for what it is. Many now view the war as a major power trying to subjugate and crush the will and determination of a neglected people who are just trying to achieve a legitimate homeland and to live in peace. The images on social media of wanton destruction and killing of innocent civilians and children has resonated around the world.

The typical Israeli citizen now understands has happened to their economy especially during the last few weeks. The worldwide call for sanctions and disinvestment has awaken a large section of the population and comparisons are often drawn with the sanction of the Old South African apartheid regime. People are now determined more then ever to get involved in boycotts and other forms of sanctions which will certainly damage the Israeli economy in the long run.

A recent survey in Israeli thinks neither side won the conflict but still approve the Israeli government actions .However in the long run when the economy weakens and the fall out from this dangerous conflict is fully examined, Israeli may not like the fact that the strategic and long term victory will be that of Hamas. It is then they will question their existing leaders and perhaps consider bringing a change of government which will hopefully bring about the lasting peace, security and economic advancements which both Palestinians and Israelis deserve.

ast month sadly saw the passing of a local stalwart who had dedicated his life toward the betterment of society and in particular young people. Farid Karolia leaves behind a legacy of selfless acts for the greater good.

Over five decades, Faridbhai dedicated his life to promote cricket in the minority communi-

ties across Batley and Dewsbury. In 2010 he received an outstanding service to cricket award and in 2012 the Yorkshire Cricket Board renamed their annual under 11's trophy after the man who worked tirelessly and influenced so many young people.

A short while before he passed away he was notified of winning the 'Numan Shabbir Syed Award for Services to Black Minority Ethnic Cricket' presented by Yorkshire CC. The award was collected on his behalf by his brother Yusuf Mia Karolia just days after Faridbhai passed away.

As one of the founder members of Mount Cricket Club and told Paigaam how it was formed because of a lack of playing opportunities for Asian cricketers in the area. In 2008 when Batley CC were struggling and looking for someone to take over the running of it, Faridbhai saw it as more than an opportunity, he saw it as an achievement. The same club where he was once told by a player 'no Asian would ever play' for the club, was now looking to be rescued by local Asian cricketers. Subsequently Faridbhai became chair at the club.



His dedication and selfless acts saw the fondness he held for 'his boys' equally reciprocated by his youngsters. During an interview with Paigaam last year he told us of how at the funeral of his first wife in 2009 a number of unfamiliar youngsters led a gentleman to ask if they were at the right funeral, they replied 'Farid uncle is like our second father.' Farid told us this meant more to him than the cabinet full of trophies behind him, adding:

"Those words were the best words. That these kids look at me that way, and it is appreciated."

> Even with his dedication to cricket he still had time to help in other areas including as a volunteer at the IMWS. As well as representing Dark Lane and MPIT on the executive committee Farid played an important role coaching U13s and U15s in the Al-Hikmah Sports Hall. He was also responsible for one of the worlds most famous Umpires Dickie Bird attending an opening ceremony at the centre. The humble gentleman's role at IMWS lasted many years and the communitv is better off for it.

Faridbhai's brother, Yusuf Mia, told us of how fortunate he was to have Faridbhai as a brother and how he encouraged him towards cricket from a young age. He said "His [Farid's] values were family, friendship, unity, community and humanity, and he best expressed these through being honest, being helpful, his humour and crick-

"He was a simple man who always worked for the greater good and very humble."

Faridbhai's humour was legendary, it seemed none could walk away from a meeting with him without having a laugh and, as Yusuf Mia recalls, "always putting a smile on peoples faces even through adversity."

It was this closeness which he so easily gained with people that led to so many attending his funeral prayer, and so many needing to be consoled.

His words of wisdom were just as powerful, a favoured quote 'You know that a team has been led by a brilliant leader when the leader moves on and the team continues to be brilliant' speaks volumes in selflessness.

He undoubted was a remarkable individual who touched many lives over many years. As his brother sums up, "A father, a brother, a role model and everybody's best friend."

May the Almighty grant Farid Bhai a high status in Jannah, give patience to his loved ones and allow the rest of us to learn the lessons of a truly selfless community stalwart.

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Batley library under threat

All but two libraries in Kirklees are under threat of closure as the council says it looks to make cuts to the tune of £140million a year.

Only Dewsbury and Huddersfield libraries would be left open, meaning that Batley library would be shut down and 100 jobs lost.

This is one of two options being considered. The other would see hubs in Dewsbury, Batley, Cleckheaton, Birstall, Heckmondwike and Mirfield – but it isn't known whether towns would have to compete for these hubs.

The second option would still see 60 jobs lost.

Kirklees council says the decision is as a result of funding being cut by central government.

Batley and Spen MP Mike Wood said that the cuts would be "impossible" to reverse in the future.

Mr Wood said: "I am very concerned that all four of the libraries in Batley and Spen are under threat. This is not something I want to see nor my constituents.

"I have no doubt this is something our councillors don't want either."

Conservative MP for Dewsbury Simon Reevell criticised Kirklees council saying "Lots of local authorities are being asked to save a lot of money. I don't accept those are the only options."

However Kirklees council leader Cllr David Sheard hit back saying "What is his suggestion? We wouldn't be talking about a nuclear option if we didn't have £140m cut from our budget every year."

He went onto warn that further services face cuts in addition to libraries.

A petition which had been launched by the Batley History Group last January after rumours had surfaced that the Batley library building was to be sold off, has been revived.

Library restructuring is due to go on until April 2017.

Confusion looms over new District **Committee powers**

The first meeting of the new Batley and Spen District Committee was clouded in confusion as to the actual decisions the committee will be responsible for and the public consultation due to be conducted in October. Kirklees Council have implementinto. There, so ed four district committees replacing long as you're the existing area committees. The announcement in June suggested devolving some decision-making powers to local councillors, community organisations and local people. But the first meeting held at Batley Town hall towards the end of August showed councillors were unclear to the actual role the committees will play, and that the scheme was in a transitional period.

> Public consultation is due to be conducted in October, almost two months after the committees began their first meetings.

> Members of the public from across the Batley and Spen wards who attended the meeting asked how well the date and venue had been promoted. Around 60 people attended which is a fraction of the community. There were also concerns raised why less than half of the elected councillors were present.

Budgets for the committees are yet to be set and the role yet to be clarified, but a sense of suspicion lingered in the atmosphere as to why this change had been pushed through council without any public or wider council consultation.

n a quiet, unassuming office a father of three from Batley is beaming with pride.

Both of Akhtar Kasia's older children Fayaz Kasia, 19 and Aadilhusain Kasia, 22 were chosen as two of the three medal bearers from the UK.

Akhtar said: "It was a long application process; they had to visit Glasgow a few times for an interview and stuff.

"They obviously specified that they wanted to be medal bearers, because my eldest had already done the ceremonies at the London Olympics and Paralympics he had a bit of experience in terms of the application process.

"So with his guidance my middle son Fayaz got involved as well and they got chosen as medal bearers."

Fayaz handled the medal ceremonies at the boxing and weightlifting, whilst Aadilhusain took care of presentation duties at the athletics.

Over the games the duo met several athletes as well as rubbing



shoulders with key people. Fayaz helped present the gold medal to boxer Nicola Adams and also met professional boxer Amir Khan.

"My eldest [Aadilhusain] met all the athletes including Usain Bolt and he took a selfie with Usain Bolt as well," says Akhtar.

Both of the boys were joined by their family at the conclusion of the games, as the whole family was won over by the warmth of the Glaswegians.

Proud father Akhtar visited them when he could due to work commitments, but has been in touch with both his sons and eager to share photos he reaches for his phone, scrolling through various snaps they have taken.

"We're quite proud to be honest because there were only three people from the whole of the UK who got chosen as medal bearers and they were two of them.


"There were a lot of other volunteers but in regards to the medal ceremonies because it's a prestige event," he says.

Both his medal bearing sons have come away with plenty of inspiration says Akhtar. "Fayaz was doing the weightlifting and because the Paralympic weightlifting was happening at the same time he saw people with no legs lifting 180-200 kilo weights and that's kind of inspired him."



EMPLOYEE'S RIGHT TO REQUEST FLEXIBLE WORKING ARRANGEMENTS

From 30 June 2014, all employees have the right to ask their employer for a change of contractual terms and conditions of employment so that they can work flexibly, provided they have worked for 26 weeks continuously by the date on which the application is made. Previously the right only applied to the parents of children under 17(or 18 in the case found on the ACAS website.

of parents of disabled children) or to those with caring responsibilities for

The statutory procedure for considering request is now removed and replaced by the ACAS code of Practice. This contains guidance on an employer's duty to consider all request in a reasonable manner and to reach a decision within three months(unless an extension is agreed). However, employers can refuse a request on business grounds, provided it is for one or more of 8 reasons specified in the EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS ACT 1996. All employers should consider applications carefully and must not discriminate against protracted groups like disable people.

In addition an employer must also ensure that part time workers are treated consistently with other workers. The Acas code of practice can be

Andrew Bolland of Stop Hate UK, a Leeds based organisation said: "In general we haven't seen any dramatic spikes across Leeds or West Yorkshire. The number of recorded hate crimes of all types has actually gone down, but that doesn't necessarily mean that fewer crimes are happening - it could be because victims don't know how or choose not to report."

The Report It! initiative is being run by the Building Bridges project from the Hamara centre in Beeston. An announcement is expected this autumn as work continues on reporting of hate crime a spokesperson for the police and crime commissioner said.

In Kirklees more reporting centres are being opened as well as victims and witnesses can report and seek help at their local Kirklees library.

Rotherham inquiry failed to protect vulnerable children

n independent Inquiry commissioned Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council has found serious failings in local authorities protecting vulnerable children. The report author Professor Alexis Jay OBE found around 1400 children were sexually exploited over a period 16 years, and found the main perpetrators were gangs of men with Pakistani heritage. It also states young girls from all backgrounds were

The appalling nature of the abuse has horrified the public. Victims of child sexual exploitation (CSE) were raped by multiple perpetrators, trafficked to other towns and cities in the North of England, abducted, beaten, tortured and intim-

According to an earlier report the violent nature of the gangs meant not only the victims but the local Asian community who had suspicions against the perpetrators feared speaking out as they would themselves be targeted by the

Another report published in 2006 described how the appeal of organised sexual exploitation for Asian gangs had changed from personal gratification to 'career and financial opportunities to young Asian men who got involved'.

Professor Jay states in the atest report that there is no simple link between race and child sexual exploitation, and across the UK the greatest numbers of perpetrators of CSE are white men. She also says although the majority of victims were white girls, women and girls of Pakistani-heritage are also targeted.

The report states:

"Local Pakistani women's groups described how Pakistani-heritage girls were

targeted by taxi drivers and on occasion by older men lying in wait outside school gates at dinner times and after school. They also cited cases in Rotherham where Pakistani landlords befriended Pakistani women and girls on their own for purposes of sex, then passed on their name to other men who had then contacted them for sex. The women and girls feared reporting such incidents to the Police because it would affect their future marriage prospects."

The UK Muslim Women's Network produced a report on CSE last year which found 35 case studies of women from across the UK who were victims, the majority of whom were Muslim. It highlighted that Asian girls were being sexually exploited where authorities were failing to identify or support them. They were most vulnerable to men from their own communities who manipulated cultural norms to prevent them from reporting their abuse.

The Deputy Children's Commissioner's report reached a similar conclusion stating "one of these myths was that only white girls are victims of sexual exploitation by Asian or Muslim males.

"This belief flies in the face of evidence that shows that those who violate children are most likely to target those who are closest to them and most easily accessible."

The report states over the first twelve years covered by the Inquiry, the collective failures of political and officer leadership were blatant. It says from the beginning there was growing evidence that child sexual exploitation was a serious problem in Rotherham.

uslims in Leeds are being urged VI to report hate crime, as police look to improve the way they record such incidents.

In an attempt to show the numbers of offences committed against particular religious groups, West Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner Mark Burns-Williamson pledged to look at recording hate crimes.

Despite various sets of data gathered by organisations such as Tell Mama, which show that hate crime against Muslims has risen. Building Bridges project co-ordinator, Tafazal Mohammed said it was difficult to assess whether there was a rise in Islamophobia in Leeds.

"In some parts of London there is evidence that anti-Muslim hate crimes have gone up several hundred per cent," said Tafazal.

There was a need for more statistics in Leeds. He said: "In Leeds we



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












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

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Controversial changes come into force at Dewsbury Hospital

A children's assessment unit has been opened at Dewsbury Hospital beginning the implementation of controversial cuts which caused protests and petitions last year.

The new unit has been opened at the side of the A&E department and means most children requiring over night admission will be transferred to Pinderfields. Ward 7 (children's ward at Dewsbury) is now being used only as an outpatient and day care unit.

According to Mid Yorkshire Hospitals NHS Trust 80 per cent of children who currently stay at hospital will be treated at the assessment unit, and around one to two children daily will have to be transferred to Pinderfields.

The Secretary of State Jeremy Hunt gave the plans the official go ahead last October and though recent-



ly selected Labour PPC's, Jo Cox and Paula Sherriff, launched a petition after the new head of the NHS, Simon Stevens, said he favoured smaller community based hospitals the cuts have already begun.

Changes to the children's services at the hospital have now been implemented and

the changes to maternity and A&E are likely to follow

The Trust had said during the public consultation the changes were likely to come into effect around 2016/ 17. Which places the new children's assessment unit ahead of schedule.

UK Gujarati poets gain recognition in new books

uiarati Writers Guild UK and Guiarati Writers Forum Batley joined forces in a Mushaira (poetry) programme which saw the launch of three books featuring work from poets living in the UK with a Gujarati heritage.

Writer and compiler of the books Dr Balvant Jani, dean of Gujarati Bhasha Bhavan, Saurashtra University, Rajkot, was the chief guest and spoke of the extensive research he had conducted to find the hidden poets across Britain.

Over a five-year period Dr Jani found some 71 poets and their literature features in the books launched during the event at the PKWA.

Two strikes and your banned!

he transport secretary recently suggested doubling the in place three points for using a mobile phone whilst driving. This would inevitably mean if caught twice the culprit would face a motoring ban.

Driving and using your mobile phone is hardly a sensible act, and yet it has become so common even the most conscientious driver occasionally tries to get away at a sneak peak of what that last alert ring was all about.

The existing three points and a £100 fine, which could go up to £1000, doesn't seem to be discouraging enough. Motoring groups have even said some motorists are not aware that checking social media sites whilst driving is illegal.

Some are of the opinion it's fine to check your mobile whilst stationary at a set of lights - according to research from a motoring group - it isn't.

The law states it is illegal to ride a motorcycle or drive using handheld phones or similar devices and that this rule also applies whilst stopped at traffic lights or queuing in traffic. In some cases the driver can be taken to court and banned from driving out-

As for new drivers, if they get six or more penalty points within two years of passing they would lose their licence.

In fact the law states a mobile phone can only be used in a vehicle to call the emergency services or when the vehicle is parked safely.

Hands-free devices can be used, however, if a police officer thinks you are distracted by using them, you could still be stopped and penalised.

But even with existing fines and penalties drivers continue to use

a mobile thinking they can get away with it.

Alternative ideas have been suggested such as wifi lay-bys, where free internet access might encourage drivers not to take the risk of using their smart phones whilst driving. Smart idea but in the fast paced world we live in

would people pull over even for free wifi?

Another is to have signal jammers fitted to cars. The idea being if the alerts are not coming in the driver will remain focussed on the road ahead. The down side- how to decipher between the drivers phone and the passengers. And the idea stumbles there.

Belgium road safety experts tried a different method in 2012. They told learners the government had brought in an extra test of texting and driving without



hitting any of the positioned obstacles. Of course it was a lie, but as the learners crashed into the obstacles, it suddenly dawned on them as to the dangers of using your mobile whilst driving.

The shock therapy and the doubling of points on your licence may well be the answer to an offence which continues to rise. Around 1.3 million accidents last year were blamed on the driver using a mobile phone, that's 26 per cent of all pileups.







A Healthy Hajj

Hajj is one of the five pillars of Islam that is compulsory for every Muslim. There are great physical and spiritual benefits for the believers in this great act of worship. The aim of this article is to provide some tips and answer some common health related questions for pilgrims.

Do I have to perform Hajj if I am unwell?

Islam is a religion of tolerance and understanding and therefore somebody who is physically unable to perform the Hajj because of illness or infirmity are exempt from going. For example, people who have chest pain at rest or minimal exertion due to angina or heart disease.

What effect may the climate and environment have on my health?

There are undoubtedly many benefits to be derived from the Holy Land and many people return from Hajj with positive changes to their

Annually more than 2 million people travel to Makkah during Hajj and this can result in overcrowding.

Depending on when you travel, the temperatures could reach as high as 45 degrees and strenuous exertion during the Hajj rites can result in heat stroke or dehydration. There is also the risk of developing blisters on the feet as well as catching coughs and colds.

Why do I need to have a Meningitis **ACWY vaccine?**

There have been outbreaks of meningitis in pilgrims in the past. If meningitis is left untreated it could lead to death. Therefore the Saudi Government has made it mandatory for all pilgrims to have the Meningitis ACWY vaccine before issuing a visa.

Is there any tips on reducing coughs and cold during my travel?

- Wash your hands with soapy water or disinfectant, especially after coughing and sneezing.
- Use disposable tissues when coughing or sneezing and dispose of them appropriately.

- Avoid hand contact with the eyes, nose and mouth.
- · Avoid direct contact with those showing symptoms of coughs and colds
- · Practice good food safety avoid undercooked meat or food prepared under unsanitary conditions, wash fruit and vegetables properly before eating them and avoid unpasteurised milk or milk products, including camel's milk.
- · Consider wearing facemasks, especially when in crowded places.

Maintain good personal hygiene. There has been concerns over the MERS-CoV virus which causes serious chest infections in the middle east. The risk is relatively low to UK travellers in the Middle-East and pilgrims are advised to follow the above tips.

Should I have any other vaccinations?

You should also consider vaccinations against typhoid, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B and polio. If you are aged over 65 years or suffer from chronic diseases you should also consider the Flu jab and the pneumococcal jab. Ensure that you have your jabs at least 10 days before you travel. Speak to your GP or the practice nurse at your local surgery for further information.

What medical kit should I carry with

If you are prescribed medicines by your GP, ensure that you take these medicines with you.

The following are items that you should consider taking with you . You can

purchase most of these from your local chemist or supermarket:

- · Simple painkillers- Paracetamol or Ibuprofen
- Plasters, bandages, scissors
- Oral rehydration salts (eg Dioralyte)
- Anti-diarrheal tablets (eg Loperamide)
- Good footwear
- Suncream (Non Perfumed) to avoid sunburns especially if you are fair skinned
- Antiseptic cream (eg Sudocrem)
- Petroleum jelly (eg Vaseline) for the feet and groin to avoid irritation when
 - Throat lozenges
 - Clove oil for toothache
 - A white umbrella
 - Water flask

Other Tips

Avoid using roadside barbers and use designated barbers. You should ensure that they use new blades to minimise the risk of catching viruses like Hepatitis B & C.

Try to avoid the midday sun and use an umbralla to reflect the sun but remember that head coverings are prohibited for men during Hajj.

Some female pilgrims may wish to delay menstruation if it is scheduled to occur during Hajj and this should be discussed well in advance with the GP who may prescribe hormonal therapy.

Be careful with what you eat. Remember the rule to avoid food poisoning: Boil it, Cook it, Peel it or Forget it!

Consider gradually increasing your physical activity- for example, building upto walking a few miles a day before you travel.

Free health care is provided for all pilgrims with 24 hour access. There are plenty of chemists where you can purchase medicines. If you are travelling via other countries then you should consider travel insurance.

ભારતમાં કરોડપતિઓની સંખ્યા ૧૪૮૦૦ છે. વિશ્વના દેશોની વાતો કરીએ તો અમેરિકામાં સૌથી વધુ ૧,૮૩૫૦૦ કરોડપતિઓ છે બીજા નંબરે ચીનમાં ૨૬૬૦૦ ત્રીજા નંબરે જર્મની ૨૫૪૦૦ ચોથા નંબરે ય.કે. માં ૨૧૭૦૦ જાપાનમાં ૨૧૦૦૦ સ્વીત્ઝર્લેન્ડમાં ૧૮૩૦૦ જ્યારે હોંગકોંગમાં ૧૫૪૦૦ કરોડપતિઓ છે

દર આઠમાં એક કેદી વિદેશી:

યુ.કે.માં જેલની સજા ભોગવી રહેલ કેદીઓમાં દર આઠ કેદીઓમાં એક કેદી વિદેશી હોવાનું એક રિપોર્ટમાં બહાર આવ્યું છે. જેલમા મુસ્લિમ કેદીઓની સંખ્યામાં પણ છ ટકા વધારો થઈ તે સંખ્યા ૧૨ હજાર ઉપર પહોંચી છે. આ ઉપરાંત હત્યા અને બળાત્કારના કેસોમાં એક હજારથી વધ અપરાધીઓ નાસ્તા કરે છે. આ રિપોર્ટમાં જેલમાં થતા હિંસાના બનાવોમાં પણ વધારો નોંધાયો છે. માર્ચના અંત સુધીમાં આવા હિંસાના કે હુમલાના કુલ ૩૩૬૩ બનાવો બન્યા હતા. જે સંખ્યા અગાઉના વર્ષે ૨૯૬૪ની હતી.

ઓછું પાણી પીનારમાં ડાચાબિટીસનો ખતરો:

ક્રાન્સ ખાતે જનરલ ડાયાબિટીસના કેસના સંશોધનમાં જાણવા મળ્યું છે કે, જે લોકો એક દિવસમાં બે ગ્લાસ કે તેનાથી ઓછું પાણી પીવે છે તેમાં હાઈ બ્લડ સુગરનું પ્રમાણ જોવા મળે છે. અને તેના કારણે આવા લોકો ડાયાબિટીસગ્રસ્ત થઈ શકે છે. અભ્યાસમાં જાણવા મળ્યું છે કે બે ગ્લાસથી ઓછું પાણી પીનારા લોકોમાં ડાયાબિટીસનો ખતરો વધી જાય છે. આનાથી જાણવા મળે છે કે, વધુ પ્રમાણમાં પાણી પીવું ખૂબજ ઉપયોગી છે. શરીરમાં ઓછા પાણીના કારણે શ્રેણીબધ્ધ રોગ થઈ શકે છે. આપણાં ડોક્ટરો કે કન્સલટનો પણ દિવસમાં ચાર કે તેથી વધુ ગ્લાસ પાણી નિયમિત રીતે પીવા સલાહ આપતા હોય છે. જે તરફ આપણે દરેકે ધ્યાન આપવું ખૂબજ જરૂરી છે.

તમે સાચા સુખને ક્ચારે માણી શકો ?

ન્યુયોર્કમાં થયેલ એક સંશોધનમાં જાણવા મળ્યું છે કે, જો તમે વાર્ષિક ૪૫ હજાર પાઉન્ડથી ઓછું કમાતા હોવ તો તમે સાચા સુખને માણી શકો છો. ન્યુયોર્કની સ્ટેટ યુનિવર્સીટીના ડો. મરિયમ તાત્ઝેલના જણાવ્યા મુજબ એક વ્યક્તિની કમાણી નો આંક જ્યારે જપહુજાર પાઉન્ડ પાર કરી જાય છે તે પછી તે

કોર્પેરેટ વિશ્વની સીડી ચઢવામાં વ્યસ્ત થઈ જાય છે. અને તે સુખ માણવાનું ભૂલી જતો હોય છે. તેમનું એમ પણ કહેવું છે કે, વાર્ષિક ૪૪૭૦૦ પાઉન્ડ કે તેથી ઓછું કમાનારા લોકો તેનાથી વધુ કમાણી કરનારા લોકો કરતા વધુ સંતોષજનક જીવન જીવતા હોય છે.

આપણે પણ રોજબરોજની જિંદગીમાં જોઈએ છીએ કે જેમની પાસે વધુ સંપત્તિ હોય છે તે તેનાથી પણ વધુ કમાવવા જીવન જીવવાની શૈલી ભૂલી જાય છે. અને તેઓ જીવનની સાચી મજા માણી શકતા નથી. જ્યારે એવા કેટલાય લોકો છે જેઓ પોતાને મળતી કમાઈમાં સંતોષ અનુભવે છે અને જિંદગીનો લ્હાવો લઈ સુખમય જીવન ગુજારે છે.

મિલિયનો પાઉન્ડનો ટેક્ષ કાઉન્સીલે કર્યો માફ:

કર્કલીઝ કાઉન્સિલ ઓથોરિટીએ એપ્રિલ ૨૦૧૩ થી માર્ચ ૨૦૧૪ દરમ્યાન ૭.૪ મિલિયન પાઉન્ડના રેન્ટ. કાઉન્સીલ ટેક્ષ અને બીઝનેશ ટેક્ષ માફ (રાઈટ ઓફ) કર્યા છે. ગયા વર્ષે (૨૦૧૨-૧૩ માં) ૮.૧ મિલિયન પાઉન્ડના આવા ટેક્ષો માક કરવામાં આવ્યા હતા.

આવા સંજોગોમાં લોકોના મનમાં એક પ્રશ્ન જરૂર ઊભો થાય છે કે, શું દર વર્ષે કાઉન્સિલ આવા મિલિયનો પાઉન્ડના ટેક્ષો રાઈટ ઓફ કરી નુકસાન સહન કરે છે અને બીજી તરફ તેમની સુવિધાઓમાં સ્પેન્ડીંગ કટ કરે છે તે કેટલું વ્યાજબી છે? શું ટેક્ષ વસુલીની સારી પધ્ધતિ અમલી ન બનાવી શકાય? આખરે આ નુકસાનનો બોજો તો કર્કલીઝમાં રહેતા લોકો ઉપર જ પડે છે.

આપણે પણ મોઢું મીઠું કરવું છે પરંતુ ગાંગડી મોઢાંમાંથી કાઢવી નથી. માણસ કડવાશ થૂંકી નથી નાંખતો, પણ એનો ઉપયોગ બીજા પર થું થું કરવામાં કરે છે. અહીં કહેવાનું તાત્પર્ય એ છે, આપણને મીઠાશથી વર્તવાનું ગમે છે, પરંતુ આપણા મોંમાંથી ઝરતા કડવા વેણ પર કાબુ મેળવવાની કોશિશ કરવી નથી. માણસે સારા થવું છે, પરંતુ હ્રદયમાં વસી ગયેલી ઈર્ષા, અહમ અને શબ્દોની કડવાશને છોડવી નથી, અને જ્યાં સુધી આપણાં વર્તનમાં ફેરફાર નહીં થાય ત્યાં સુધી આપણે સંબંધોની મીઠાશને સમજી શકીશું નહીં. જરૂરત છે આપણાં વર્તનમાં નમ્રતા અને સદવર્તન અપનાવવાની.

છેલ્લા ૧૨ વર્ષમાં માત્ર અમેરિકામાંથી એ કટ્ટરપંથી સમર્થકોએ ૫૫૦ લાખ ડોલરની નાણાંકીય મદદ મોકલાવી હતી. જેનો મુખ્ય હેતુ મુસ્લિમો અને દલિતો (હિન્દ્રઓમાં પછાત ગણાતી કોમ) ને તમામ સુવિધાઓથી વંચિત રાખવા, શિક્ષણ ક્ષેત્રે પાછળ રાખવા, વેપાર ધંધા અને નોકરીઓથી વંચિત રાખવાનો મતલબ કે લઘુમતિઓની પ્રગતિને રૂંધવાના બદ ઈરાદાથી આવી નાણાંકીય સહાય બીજેપી અને સંઘ પરિવારને કરોડો રૂપિયામાં મળી રહી છે.

અન્ય એનજીઓ (N.G.O.) ને મળતી પરદેશથી ચેરિટિ રૂપે આર્થિક સહાય પર ચાંપતી દેખરેખ રાખવાનું મોદી સરકાર ગંભીરતાથી વિચારી રહી છે. જેમાં સંઘને મળતા નાણાં પરત્વે એવી કોઈ તપાસ કરવામાં આવશે નહીં. મતલબ કે. ભવિષ્યમાં જો કોઈ નિયંત્રણ લાદવામાં આવશે તો સંઘને એવા નિયંત્રણથી બાકાત રાખવામાં આવશે. અગર એ સમાચારમાં સચ્ચાઈ હશે તો આવા એક તરકી નિર્ણયોથી અન્ય કોમોને મળતી પરદેશની સહાય પર જબરી અસર થશે. અને ખાસ કરીને મુસ્લિમોના હિતાર્થે કામ કરતી સંસ્થાઓને ભારે નુકસાન થવાની સંભાવના છે.

આવં જ કંઈક આ સંસ્થા તરકથી આયોજીત થતા ઘણાં પ્રોગામમાં આપણાં સમાજના લોકોની નજીવી હાજરીથી કાર્યકર્તાઓ પણ શરમની લાગણી અનુભવે છે, અને બહારથી આવનાર વિધ્વાન વક્તાઓ ઉપર પણ તેની ખરાબ અસર પડે છે. છેલ્લા સાત માસમાં અલ-હિકમાહ સેન્ટર ખાતે કમિટિના અથાગ પ્રયત્નોથી એન્યુલ લેકચર, શીરા કોન્ફરન્સ, યુથ યુનિટિ ફન ડે જેવા ખૂબજ અગત્યના પ્રોગ્રામો આપણી કોમ્યુનિટિના લાભાર્થે થયા હતા. પરંતુ દુઃખદ ઘટના એ હતી કે તેમાં લોકોની હાજરી ખૂબજ ઓછી હતી. જો ભવિષ્યમાં પણ આવુંજ થતું રહ્યું, તો આવા અગત્યના અને જરૂરી પ્રોગ્રામો રાખતા પહેલા સંસ્થાએ પણ વિચાર કરવો પડશે.

સ્વાભાવિક રીતે કોઈ પણ સેમિનાર કે પ્રોગ્રામ વગેરેની સકળતાનો આધાર તે. પ્રોગ્રામમાં લોકોની હાજરી કે મેદની ઉપર હોય છે. ઉપરાંત તે સભાઓમાં લોકોની હાજરી અને તે પ્રત્યેના રસ અને સભાનતાથી વકતાઓને પણ બયાનો કે વકત્વયો વગેરે રજ કરવામાં સહકાર મળે છે. કોઈ પણ સંસ્થા જે તે પ્રોગ્રામનું આયોજન કરે તેમાં સમય, પૈસા, અને મહેનત વપરાતી હોય છે. આટલા બધા પ્રયત્નો પછી આયોજિત આવા પ્રોગ્રામોનો લ્હાવો મળતો હોય ત્યારે સમાજના એક સદસ્ય તરીકે આપણી પણ કરજ બને છે કે આપણાં કામકાજમાંથી થોડો સમય કાઢી એમાં હાજરી આપીએ, જેથી તેનો લાભ દરેકને મળી શકે.

વિશ્વના અનેક દેશોમાં હોસ્પિટલ તરફથી દર્દીઓ પ્રત્યે દાખવવામાં આવતી બેદરકારી કે ભુલના અનેક બનાવો આપણે સાંભળીયે છીએ. ઓસ્ટેલીયાના મેલ્બોર્ન શહેરની ઓસ્ટીન હોસ્પિટલમાં પણ કંઈક આવુંજ બન્યું હતું. હોસ્પિટલમાં સારવાર લઈ રહેલ ૨૦૦ જેટલા દર્દીઓને હોસ્પિટલમાંથી રજા આપવાના (ડીસ્ચાર્જ) કેસમાં ઓફીસરની ભુલના કારણે દર્દીઓના જાપી ને ડીસ્ચાર્જના બદલે દર્દીઓ મરણ પામ્યા છે એવા લેટરો મોકલવામાં આવ્યા હતા. ભૂલનું કારણ એ હતું કે ડીસ્ચાર્જ અને મરણના સ્ટાનડર્ડ લેટરમાં ડીસ્ચાર્જની જગ્યાએ અધિકારીએ મરણના ટેમ્પલેટ કાગળનો ઉપયોગ કર્યો હતો. આ બાબતની ખબર ત્યારે પડી જ્યારે કે એક દર્દીના સગાએ કેમિલિ મેમ્બરને આશ્વાસન પાઠવવા કોન કર્યો હતો. પાછળથી હોસ્પિટલના અધિકારીઓએ પત્ર લખી આ અંગે માકી માંગી હતી પરંતુ આવી ભૂલના કારણે જીપી અને સગાઓ ખૂબજ નારાજ હતા.

બાટલીમાં પુસ્તક વિમોચન અને મુશાયરો

રવિવાર તા. ૧૭મી ઓગપ્ટ ૨૦૧૪ના રોજ બાટલીના PKWA Centre ખાતે સૌરાષ્ટ્ર યુનિવર્સિટી, રાજકોટના ગુજરાતી ભાષા ભવનના વડા ડૉ બળવંત જાની દ્વારા સંપાદિત ત્રણ પુસ્તકોના વિમોચન માટે એક કાર્યક્રમનું આયોજન કરવામાં આવ્યું હતું. આ કાર્યક્રમ અહીંની બે જાણીતી સાહિત્યિક સંસ્થાઓ **ગુજરાતી રાઇટર્સ ફોરમ, બાટલી** અને **ગુજરાતી રાઇટર્સ ગિલ્ડ, યુ.કે.** દ્વારા યોજવામાં આવ્યો હતો. ડૉ જાનીએ ઝીણવટભર્યા સંશોધન અને અથાગ મહેનતને પરિણામે જે ત્રણ પુસ્તકોનું સચોટ અને સુંદર સંપાદન કર્યું છે તે પુસ્તકોમાં (૧) બ્રિટીશ ગુજરાતી ડાયસ્પોરા કાવ્ય ધારા (૨) બ્રિટીશ ગુજરાતી ડાયસ્પોરા વાર્તા ધારા અને (૩) બ્રિટીશ ગુજરાતી ડાયસ્પોરા નિબંધ ધારાનો સમાવેશ થાય છે.

કાર્યક્રમની શરૂઆત કરતાં ગુજરાતી રાઇટર્સ ફોરમ, બાટલીના સેક્રેટરી ઇસ્માઇલ દાજીએ 'ફોરમ'ની પ્રવૃત્તિઓ પર પ્રકાશ ફેંકયો હતો અને મહેમાનો તથા ઉપસ્થિત શ્રોતાઓનું સ્વાગત કર્યું હતું. ત્યાર બાદ ગુજરાતી રાઇટર્સ ગિલ્ડ, યુ.કે.ના સેક્રેટરી સિરાજ પટેલ પગુથનવીએ ગિલ્ડની સ્થાપના અને વિકાસયાત્રા પર ઘણી વિગતે વાત કરતાં જણાવ્યું હતું કે સ્થાપનાકાળથી લઇ આજ સુધીમાં ગિલ્ડે યુ.કે.ના વિવિધ ટાઉનો અને શહેરોમાં સો જેટલા મુશાયરાઓનું આયોજન કરી લોકોને ગઝલો-હઝલોની લહાણી કરાવવા સાથે છેલ્લા પાંચ દાયકાથી અહીં બ્રિટનમાં અને ખાસ કરીને લેંકેશાયરમાં ગુજરાતી ભાષાને જીવંત રાખી છે.

હવે પુસ્તક વિમોચનની ઘડી આવી પડી હતી. વાર્તાધારા પુસ્તકનું વિમોચન બાટલીના જાણીતા જી.પી. અને સમાજસેવક ડૉ રાજપુરાએ, નિબંધ ધારા પુસ્તકનું IQEvent સેવીલ ટાઉન, ડયુઝબરીના માલિક અને સાહિત્યપ્રેમી ઇકબાલ ધોરીવાલાએ તથા કાવ્ય ધારાનું લંડનથી પધારેલ કવયિત્રી ભારતી પંકજે કર્યું હતું.

મુખ્ય મહેમાન ડૉ બળવંત જાનીએ પોતે હાથ ધરેલા પ્રૉજેક્ટની રૂપરેખા રજૂ કરી હતી. ગુજરાતમાં બ્રિટીશ ગુજરાતી ડાયસ્પોરા સાહિત્ય વિષે જે ધુમ્મસિયો ખ્યાલ ત્યાંના સાહિત્યકારોમાં પ્રવર્તે છે તેને દૂર કરી અહીંના સર્જકોનું સાચું ચિત્ર રજૂ કરવાનો તેમણે પ્રયાસ કર્યો છે. આજ સુધી બ્રિટનના ગુજરાતી સાહિત્ય સર્જનની ગુજરાતમાં કોઇ ખાસ નોંધ લેવાઇ નથી. તેમણે આ ત્રણ પુસ્તકોમાં સંપાદિત કરેલ માહિતી 'ધુમ્મસ પછીના ઉઘાડ'ની જેમ બ્રિટનના ગુજરાતી સાહિત્યકારોને પણ પ્રકાશમાં લાવશે એવી આશા વ્યક્ત કરી હતી. તેમણે પોતાના સંશોધન કાર્ય દરમિયાન દરેક ઠેકાણે તેમને મળેલા સુંદર સહકાર અને પ્રેમ, આદરની ભારોભાર કદર કરી આભારની લાગણી વ્યક્ત કરી હતી. તેમનો જન્મ દિવસ હોવાથી ડૉ રાજપુરા અને તેમના પત્ની આબેદાબહેને સૌને આશ્ચર્યમાં નાંખતાં સળગતી મીણબત્તી સાથે ડૉ જાની સામે બથીડે કૅક રજૂ કરી 'હેપી બર્થડે ટુ યુ'ના કૉરસ સાથે તેમના જન્મ દિવસની ઉજવણી કરી હતી. આ સમયે ડૉ જાની ભાવવિભોર થઇ ગયા હતા. બંને સંસ્થાઓ તરફથી કવિ બ્રાયન લૂઇસના હસ્તે એક સુંદર પ્લાક અર્પણ કરી ડૉ જાનીનું સન્માન કરવામાં આવ્યું હતું.

અધ્યક્ષસ્થાનેથી બોલતાં કવિ પંકજ વોરાએ આને એક ઐતિહાસિક ઘટના ગણાવી ડૉ જાનીનો આભાર માન્યો હતો.

છેલ્લે મુશાયરાની શરૂઆત કરતાં ગઝલકાર મહેક ટંકારવીએ હાજર રહેલા ૨૦ જેટલા કવિઓને પૂરતા સમયના અભાવે ઝડપથી રજૂ કરવાનું કપરુ કામ ઉપાડી લીધું હતું. બોલ્ટન, બ્લૅકબર્ન અને બાટલીના સ્થાનિક કવિઓ ઉપરાંત લેસ્ટરથી બેદાર લાજપુરી, દિલીપ ગજ્જર, મધુબેન ચાંપાનેરિયા, લંડનથી પંકજ વોરા અને ભારતી પંકજ તથા અંગૅજ કવિ બ્રાયન લૂઇસે પોતાનાં કાવ્યો રજૂ કર્યા હતાં.

فلسطینی اسرائیلی جیلوں میں قید 2000

فلسطین میں انسانی حقوق کے لیے کام کرنے والے گرویوں نے انکشاف کیا ہے کہ قابض اسرائیلی فوج نے پچھلے دوماہ کے دوران فلسطین کے مختلف شہر ول میں و حشیانہ کریک ڈاؤن میں 2000 فلسطینیوں کو حراست میں لے کر جیلوں میں ڈالا۔ زیادہ تر گر فتاریاں مقبوضہ مغربی کنارے کے شہر ول، بیت المقدس اور فلسطین کے دوسرے مقامات سے کی گئی جس کے بعد اسرائیلی جیلوں میں یابند سلاسل فلسطینیوں کی تعداد 5سے بڑھ کر 7000 ہو گئی ہے۔ مرکز اطلاعات فلسطین کے مطابق اسٹڈی سینٹر برائے امور اسپر ان کی جانب سے جاری ایک تازہ رپورٹ میں بتایا گیاہے کہ نہتے فلسطینیوں کی بلاجواز گر فقاریوں کا تازہ سلسلہ وسط جون میں مغربی کنارے کے الخلیل شہر میں تین یہودی آباد کاروں کی پراسرار گم شدگی کے بعد شروع ہوا۔ ایک ماہ میں اسرائیلی فوج نے مغربی کنارے کے مختلف شہر وں میں 150 سرچ آپریشن اور گر فتاریوں کے لیے کریک ڈاؤن کیے جن میں خواتین، بچوں سمیت سیکڑوں فلسطینیوں کو قید کر کے جیلوں میں ڈال دیا گیا۔ حراست میں لیے جانے والے بڑی تعداد میں شہریوں کو بغیر کسی الزام کے انتظامی حراست میں منتقل کرادیا گیا۔ گر فمار کیے گئے تازہ فلسطینیوں کے خلاف اسر ائیلی عدالتوں سے عجلت میں مقدمات قائم کرائے گئے اور انہیں دانستہ طور پر جیلوں میں یابند سلاسل کرنے کی راہ ہموار کی گئی۔ فلسطینی اسیر ان کے امور پر نظر رکھنے والے تجزیبے نگار عبدالناصر فروانہ نے اس موضوع پر انسانی حقوق کے ادارے سے بات کرتے ہوئے بتایا کہ حراست میں لیے گئے قیدیوں کو بھیکڑ بکریوں کی طرح عقوبت خانوں میں ٹھونسا گیاہے جہاں انہیں بنیادی انسانی حقوق بھی میسر نہیں ہیں۔ زخمیوں میں کئی زخمی اور مریض ہیں لیکن وہ اسرائیلی فوج کے ظالمانہ ہتھکنڈوں کاسامنا کرتے ہوئے اب جیلوں میں بدترین مظالم بھی حجیل رہے

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
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
